Quarryhill is a living collection, an Asian woodland in the rolling hills above Glen Ellen. The mature garden hosts a rich diversity of Asian flora, grown from seed collected in the wild on over 22 expeditions, and re-creates the endangered habitats of eastern Asia, including China, Japan and Korea.



Advancing the conservation, study and cultivation of the flora of Asia

Educational school tours at Quarryhill teach concepts in:

- Botany, plant parts, plant biology & adaptation
- Earth science: water cycle; rock cycle
- Ecology, conservation, endangered species
- Asian culture—flower meanings, medicinal plants, haiku
- The connection between modern gardens and Asian-origin plants
